### From a higher level

This is the most complex pattern in Denmark's 33 years of crop-circle history until now, on a par with the high-level crop circles in Southwest England. The laws of probability overwhelmingly show that the coordinated details in this whole complicated system, with its several meaningful deeper layers, were wholly intentional. It also contains numerous clear proofs that it was not made by humans in the field, but by some more developed intelligence using some advanced, precise

energetic technology, which humanity does not at present have.

The downed plants were all bent at ground level and still living, none were broken. The standing curved borders were sharply defined, not erratic. The crop's lay showed several patterns within patterns which were too flowing and precise to be made by our handheld-tools in the field. The mathematical and geometrical repetitive precision and coordination showed exactly how to combine the formation's pieces. Within that result, the overlapping ground-lay's patterns illustrated systematically inter-active energy-channels.

The combined documentation shows that this pattern is a diagram of some 4-storied energetic system and object, which also has outlets to its surrounding near and far environments.

### General background

The formation was 55 meters long and 21 meters wide, with unusual features in all of its 11 downed sections. There's a Bonze Age raised burial mound at the field's far edge. It was in a large field near a couple houses and next to a countryside road. Driving uphill, it was easily visible, but driving downhill, it was totally hidden by the mature wheat. Time-consuming hoaxing would have been easily discovered. It had gotten no publicity, and was thus not created for fame or to produce some public response. It was in practically new condition when we examined it, so very few people had been in it, and the local neighborhood's harvesting was already almost completed.

### The downed crop's many patterns within patterns

The field sloped diagonally, and the axis in the long, straight crop-circle lay precisely on top of and paralleled this slope. Its pattern lay at a slant to the crossed

tractor paths, and there was always a brief disturbance in the straws' lay at those places.

The crop's lay was everywhere powerful and bold. It created an awing and very aesthetic experience, when visually combined with its standing sharp boundaries. In all the formation's swirled sections, the crop's lay was counter-clockwise. The 4 large, concentric standing rings within the formation's largest circular area somehow induced a pleasantly flowing confusion in us when we walked around within them, so it was at times momentarily hard to keep our natural orientation steady there.

#### The central connecting path

There was an impressive 2-meters wide downed path, with its stalks running 32 meters from SW to NE, through the middle of most of the long formation. It determines the formation's forward and back/ up and down directions, as their spikes there all pointed one way, and stalks grow upwards, not downwards.

This central path started nearby the center of the 7-meters long circle in the first 12-meters long circular area; ran through all of the second, largest, 21-meters long circular area with its 4 rings, and divided that section's core into two separated semi-circles; continued up to the central area in the third 12-meters long circle, and ended there by gradually merging into that circle's counter-clockwise swirl.

#### Energy circulation: the swirling rings

Within the largest section, wherever each of its 4 rings met this transversing central path, there was this same overlapping pattern:

The downed crop began just outside the path's one side, ran around  $\frac{1}{2}$  the large ring or circle and overlapped the path on that same side, pointing left; then it started just again from the path's opposite side and ran the other  $\frac{1}{2}$  circle, where it

again overlapped the path, pointing right. Whereas, in the first section's circle and ring, its overlaps pointed left, and in the third section's circle, they pointed right.

This proved that the path was underlying everything else, and had been downed first, but was then consecutively nudged to the left, left, right, left, right, left, right, left, right, left, right, right. Besides its forward thrust, this constant twisting from side to side creates dynamic energy and an ongoing current.

Again within the second section's rings, as the crop flowed around the standing boundary on the uphill side of a curve, there was always a set area after the highest place, along a vector pointing due East, where small bunches of stalks slanted at nearly the same sideways angle upwards and partly into the standing crop. They imply forceful spinning and twirling energy at that angle. As if the creation's swirling force spilled a little into the boundary at that place.

The most powerful slanting area, which actually flowed like the vortex in a stream of water, through a longer section of its ring, was found along the edge of the outermost 4th ring. The innermost 3 rings had a much less prominent area of these slanting bunches.

### System in movement

The combined sections' swirling patterns, illustrating the twirling parts in this coordinated 3-D system, strongly suggest that the formation is a diagram of an internally moving energy system, perhaps within a partially physical object.

Lying right on the field's slant also hints that the system can turn. Something roundish will begin to roll, and some 4-floored flat verticle object would not remain stable at that angle.

### The appendages

The formation continued beyond its transversing path with a fourth 7-meters long circle, ending in two tapered rectangular 1,5-meter long extensions pointing 45 degrees forward toward the left and right. The formation had also begun with a short separated 1,5-meter broad arc, just outside the main figure and in the field. At the end of these three appendages at both ends of the formation, all final bundles of gathered crop curved totally up along their length, leaving between them empty spaces into the standing wheat, and thereby forming open-ended boundaries there.

### Apparent and actual shapes

In my eyes, the shapes were close to symmetrical, whereas when measuring the length or breadth of various parts of a ring, circle, or pathway, the ground measurements showed diversions of between 10-60 cm. My guess is that the eyes and brain when close up automatically generalize and compensate for the slope and many distances, and see a regularized figure.

This contradiction may be because a symmetrical spiral or circle of energy descending from the air above, when hitting the sloping earth, produces predictable asymmetrical ground measurements.

This was the mathematically demonstrated case 31 years ago, concerning the 1995 crop circle found in another area of Odsherred.

### Intended combination

The geometry and math in that 1995 crop circle of concentric arcs so perfectly literally fit into this new crop circle's outermost borders, and also perfectly exactly surround it at exactly the distance of the 2026 formation's final radius, that it's clear that their symbols are meant to be combined – the new one being a complex extension of the old one - to create a larger combined symbol with an even more complex set of encoded information.

### Depth analysis

Now comes a step-by-step, more thorough, and deeper analysis - with a surprise ending: my undocumented guess about what this crop-circle represents and its purpose for us.
